I do have serious concerns with the Taylor project. Have the impacts on wildlife and water quality been properly addressed? With the restoration work done on the Nisqually Delta I have seen a significant increase in the number of forage fish using the near shore environment. This has been the first sign of improvement I have seen in the 50 years I have observed the Reach and Inlet.

I would be quite upset to think that all those positive efforts have only made the waters safe for massive aquaculture. I fear that this particular project is only the camels nose under the tent.
