- 3. Revised 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Earnings Report
  - a. A formula that was not copied down correctly in the Earnings Report reflected an incorrect average cash balance and average earnings for Q2. This only impacted Q2, and only this specific report. This has been corrected. Reports published to our investment site have been revised to show the correct amounts for Q2.
    - i. Previous average cash balance and average earnings still only reflected through the first quarter in the formula.
- 4. Quarterly Commentary (attached)
  - a. Nicole pointed out that we are on track for 2023 to have the largest dollar amount earnings on the portfolio in over 10 years, at least. Largest earnings on the portfolio recorded was \$17,896,094 in 2019. Current earnings as of September 30<sup>th</sup> is \$17,510,648. With three more months, the total earnings will breech that previous record.
  - b. Admin Fee will be adjusted January 1<sup>st</sup> to 3.5bps. Rebate to portfolio participants expected to be \$100k per month through end of year.
