This decision is based on our finding that: Petitioner Sandra Ohlinger participated in the teleconference hearing. She testified that: there is 2.02 acres of land, but the remainder is unusable property in terms of building and difficult for them to maintain; they have their own well and septic; and the home is 1,656 square feet. The Assessor's Office was represented by Appraiser Analyst Sam Howe, who prepared a written Response to the Petition. Appraiser Analyst Jacob Johansen observed the hearing. Mr. Howe testified that the Assessor's Office values a community well the same as an individual well. He reviewed the Assessor's comparable sales. He stated that the Assessor's Office primarily values properties by the square foot. The Board finds that the Petitioner provided clear and compelling testimony as well as a comparable sale. The Board adopts the Petitioner's requested value based on the testimony and evidence presented.
