This decision is based on our finding that: Petitioners Floyd and Sun Ae Driver did not participate in the teleconference hearing. On Petition, the Petitioners stated that they are unable to afford necessary repairs. No repair bids were provided. The Assessor was represented by Appraiser Analyst Sam Howe, who provided a written Response to the Petition. Mr. Howe reviewed the comparable sales in his Response. The Board cannot consider the personal hardship of the Petitioners. The Board finds that the Petitioners did not provide clear, cogent, and convincing evidence sufficient to overcome the Assessor's presumption of correctness. The Board sustains the Assessor's value.
