


March sales tax revenue totaled \$1,895,057.52.

Compared to March 2022, year-over-year growth was 6.11%, with a total increase if \$109,145.93.

March sales tax is earned during the month of January.

Year over Year growth for 2023 so far is 5%.



Total sales tax accumulation year-over-year growth for March was 6.11%.

Retail Trade made up approximately 42% of the total revenue received from sales tax. Year-over-year growth for Retail Trade was flat at .10% for an increase of just \$778. It is normal to see a strong dip in revenue in March and April. Revenue earned in March and April are in the months following the holidays.

Revenue from Construction accounted for 20% of the total sales tax revenue. Year-overyear growth for construction was up 14%.

Wholesale Trade and Manufacturing saw very strong year-over-year growth with Wholesale Trade at 35% and Manufacturing at 62%. Combined these categories make up about 9% of the total sales tax accumulation amount.
