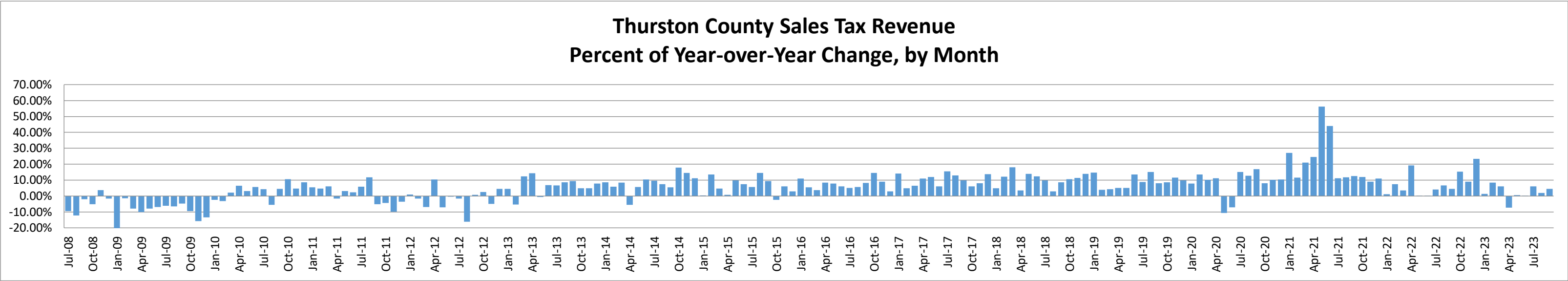


Report in Brief: Thurston County Sales Tax Revenue

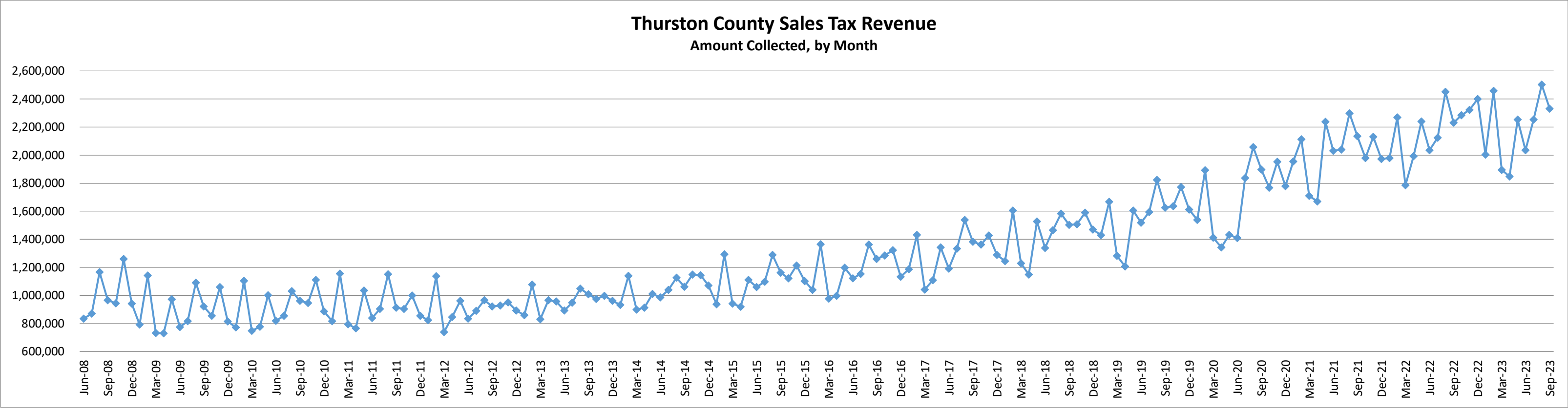


September sales tax revenue totaled \$2,330,875.02.

Compared to September 2022, year-over-year growth was 4.49%.

September sales tax is earned during the month of July.

Year over Year growth for 2023 is approximately 2.5%.

Total sales tax accumulation year-over-year (YOY) growth for September was 4.49%.

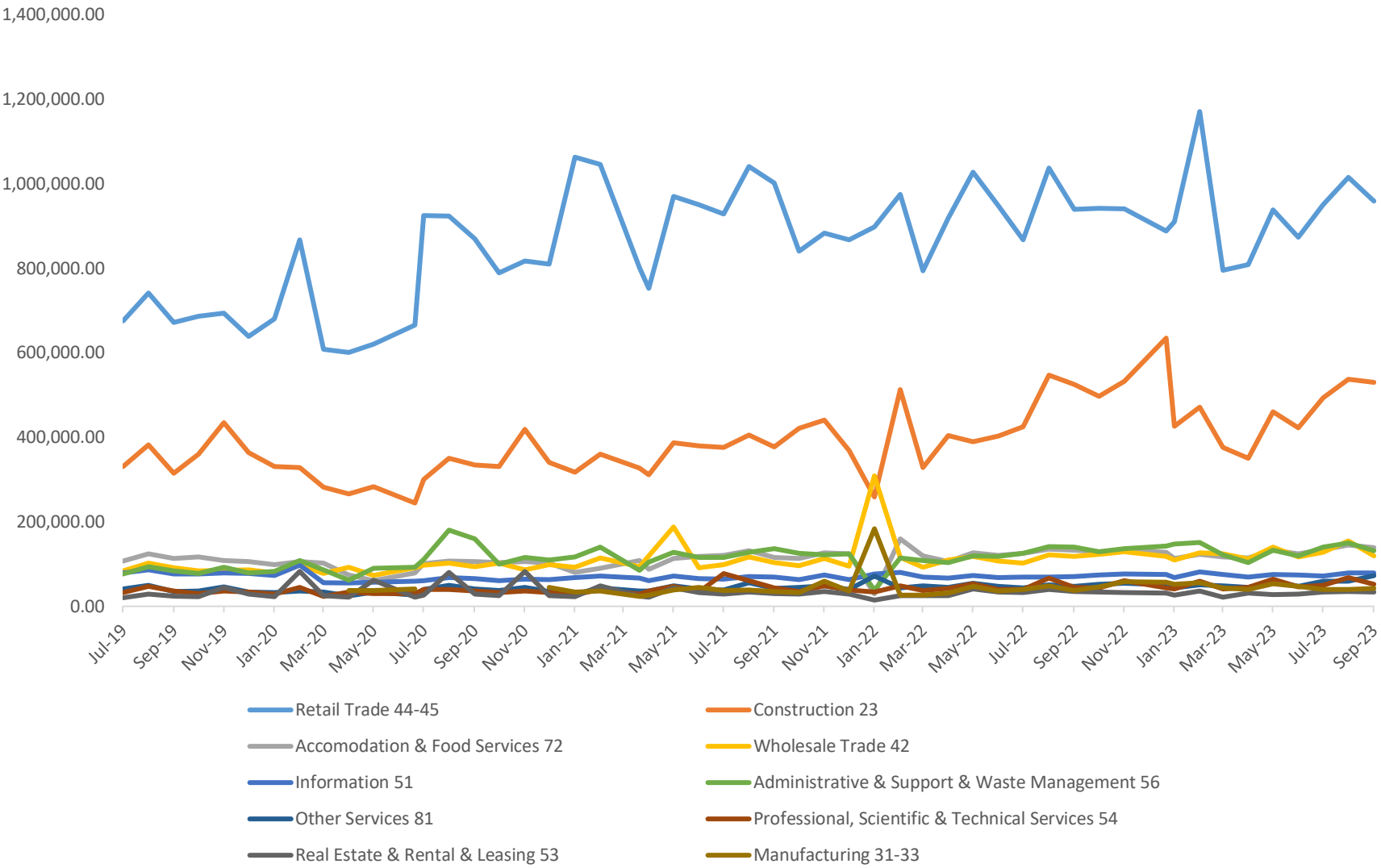
Retail Trade made up approximately 41% of the total revenue received from sales tax. Year-over-year growth for Retail Trade was 2.05% this month. The top 3 categories of Retail Trade are: Sporting Goods, Hobby, Musical Instrument, Book & Miscellaneous Store Retailers (30%); Motor Vehicle (16%); and General Merchandise (13%). General Merchandise YOY growth was down 1.7%, Sporting Goods, Hobby, Musical Instrument, Book & Miscellaneous Store Retailers was flat at 1.56%, and Motor Vehicle was at 5.82%. Food & Beverage had the strongest YOY growth at 8.98%. Food & Beverage makes up approximately 5.5% of Retail Trade sales tax revenue.

Revenue from Construction accounted for 23% of the total sales tax revenue. YOY growth for construction was flat at 1.03%.

Accommodation and Food Services accounted for just 5.94% of the total sales tax revenue. YOY growth for this sector was 4.58%

Compared to overall sales tax revenue statewide, Thurston County saw much higher growth at just over 4%.
