


December sales tax revenue totaled \$ 2,280,076.70.



Retail Trade made up approximately 48% of the total revenue received from sales tax. Year-over-year growth for Retail Trade was up 2.92% this month. The majority of the decrease in revenue came from Construction which was down \$71,514.62 from 2022.

Revenue from Wholesale Trade accounted for 12.91% of the total sales tax revenue. YOY growth for construction was down at -11.27%.

Accommodation and Food Services accounted for just 1.67% of the total sales tax revenue. YOY growth for this sector was down -1.53%.


Except for Construction, Thurston County followed similar trends to the overall sales tax accumulation in Washington State.
