Thurston County's Public Health and Social Services, [Parenting & Postpartum Support Group](#), is a family support group in Thurston County. It is designed to support families in the community who are navigating the highs and lows of pregnancy, postpartum, and parenting infants. The group meets at Thurston County Public Health and Social Services (412 Lilly Rd. NE, Olympia 98506) the first Thursday of the month, from 10:00 am to 11:30 am, and the third Thursday of the month, 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm, where dinner is provided.

This support group strives to provide a non-judgmental space to explore with families how they are feeling and doing. It is a wonderful place to get connected with other parents and experienced facilitators while navigating this journey into parenthood. The group offers parents a place to think about and process their experiences as new parents. Some topics of discussion include the impact of changes to identity, changes in our relationships with partner and others, the real impact of sleep deprivation, feelings around the birth experience, and differences between expectations and the reality of the perinatal period. This group is open to all parents in the period of pregnancy, postpartum, and parenting infants.
