





Data Notes

- All data are preliminary and may change as data is updated.
- We report data up to the last complete week.
- If the percent of emergency department visits diagnosed with a virus is above the transmission alert threshold, it is a sign that there is substantial transmission of that virus.
- Data on respiratory virus emergency department visits are reported to the Washington State Department of Health's Rapid Health Information NetwOrk (RHINO) and are stored on the National Syndromic Surveillance Program (NSSP) Biosense ESSENCE platform.
- We report hospital ED visits at Thurston County hospitals, which includes both Thurston County and non-Thurston County residents.
- If someone visits the emergency department more than once, each emergency department visit is counted. Counts do not reflect unique persons.
- Transmission alert thresholds for COVID-19, Influenza, and RSV are calculated using the <u>Moving</u>. <u>Epidemic Method</u>.
