Duties of the Council:

Advisory to the Board of County Commissioners (BoCC), paraphrased from Bylaws, Article III Scope:

- 3.1: Review and evaluate provision of publicly funded EMS /Medic One system.
- 3.2: Advise the BoCC regarding development, policies, and planning of EMS/Medic One system.
- 3.3: Make recommendation to the BoCC on the planning process, annual budget, purchase contracts in excess of county policy level, intergovernmental and personal services contracts, non-budgeted expenditures over \$1,000 and compliance of MPD.

Qualifications of Members: Qualifications for seating, term and removal for most positions are determined by the recommending group (appointing authority), for instance, the Thurston County Fire Commissioners Association, local governments, etc.

Appointed by: Board of County Commissioners.

Vacancies filled by: May be declared by the BoCC following 3 consecutive unexcused absences by member or designated alternate; recommending agency shall nominate a replacement.

Appoint & Removal: The BoCC independently appoints and removes the four citizen members, bi-annually or as otherwise needed.

Authority: BoCC resolutions 6064, 6131, 6697, 7011, 7141, 7912, 8139, 8861, 10830, 13114, 14214, 14989, and as statutorily provided for in WAC and RCW.
