<u>This decision is based on our finding that</u>: The Petitioner did not participate in the teleconference hearing. The Assessor's Office was represented by Appraiser Analyst Jacob Johansen, and the written Response to the Petition was prepared by Appraiser Analyst Sam Howe. Mr. Johansen addressed the Petitioner's concerns about structural damage noting the Assessor's Office considers this normal wear and tear and they are giving a 40% depreciation value adjustment. The Assessor's representative reviewed his 6 comparable sales of similar rambler homes of average quality. The adjusted value range from the Assessor's data is \$329,700 to almost \$425,800, which supports the assessed value of the subject property. The Board finds that the Petitioner did not provide clear, cogent, and convincing evidence sufficient to overcome the Assessor's presumption of correctness and to warrant a reduction in the valuation.
