<u>This decision is based on our finding that</u>: The Board sustains the Assessor's determination of value based on the evidence presented. The Parties did not participate in the hearing. On Petition, the Petitioners shared concerns about the neighboring duplex and provided three comparable sales in support of their requested value. The Assessor's Representative provided a written Response including a market-adjusted cost approach and a sales comparison approach in support of the current assessed value. The Board finds that the Petitioners' comparable sales occurred several months after the January 1, 2018 assessment date. The Board finds that the Petitioners did not provide clear, cogent, and convincing evidence sufficient to overcome the Assessor's presumption of correctness and to warrant a reduction in the valuation.
