On Petition, the Petitioners referenced a refinance appraisal from March 2020 The Assessor was represented by Appraiser Analyst Sam Howe. Appraisal Supervisor Teresa Hoyer provided a letter in Response to the Petition. The Assessor recommended a reduction in the value of the improvements to \$1,784,900, for a total recommended value of \$2,250,000, the same value as the Petitioners' fee appraisal.
