HOW TO GET A COURT ORDER FOR CONTEMPT

IMPORTANT!!

If you are asking for contempt of an order that was entered in <u>any</u> other county than Thurston county, then you will be required to open a Thurston County case and pay the filing fee required by the Clerk's Office. Check with the Clerk's Office for the filing fee amount. You must also have a certified copy of the out-of-county order to file with your papers.

Use the forms and instructions in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- ✓ You have one or more of the following types of Court Orders entered in a family law case:
 - Child Support Order
 - Order of Spousal Maintenance (Alimony)
 - Restraining Order
 - Parenting Plan or Custody Order
 - Temporary Order
 - Decree of Dissolution/Legal Separation/Invalidity

AND

✓ The other party is not complying with or has refused to follow that order in whole or in part.

READ ME: It is very important for you to know that when you sign a court document, you may be helping or hurting your court case. Before you sign any court document or get involved with a court case, it is important that you carefully read the document to make sure you are doing the right thing. You may also want to contact a lawyer for legal advice and help with those issues you do not understand. If you need help with the forms, procedures and rules of the court, there is a Family Court Facilitator available to assist you.
