## HOW TO FILE FOR EMERGENCY MINOR GUARDIANSHIP

## **CHECKLIST**

Use the forms and instructions in this packet only if the following factors apply to your situation:

- You need an Immediate Order appointing an emergency guardian for a minor;
- ➤ Appointment of an emergency guardian is necessary to prevent substantial harm to the minor's health, safety, or welfare; and
- Neither parent is able or willing to provide for the support, care, education, health, safety and welfare of the child(ren)

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICES**

The duration of authority of an emergency guardian for a minor may not exceed sixty days. That authority may be extended once for not more than sixty days if the court finds good cause (RCW 11.130.225). If you need a longer appointment, then you must start a new case to file for Minor Guardianship Custody (RCW 11.130.185).

If you are seeking custody of a child who is or may be an Indian child as defined by the Indian Child Welfare Act, 25 USC § 1903, notice of this action must be given in accordance with 25 U.S.C. § 1912 (a). Please review additional packet on "Indian Child Welfare Notice."

READ ME: It is very important for you to know that when you sign a court document, you may be helping or hurting your court case. Before you sign any court document or get involved with a court case, it is important that you carefully read the document to make sure you are doing the right thing. You may also want to contact a lawyer for legal advice and help with those issues you do not understand. If you need help with the forms, procedures and rules of the court, there is a Family Court Facilitator available to assist you.
