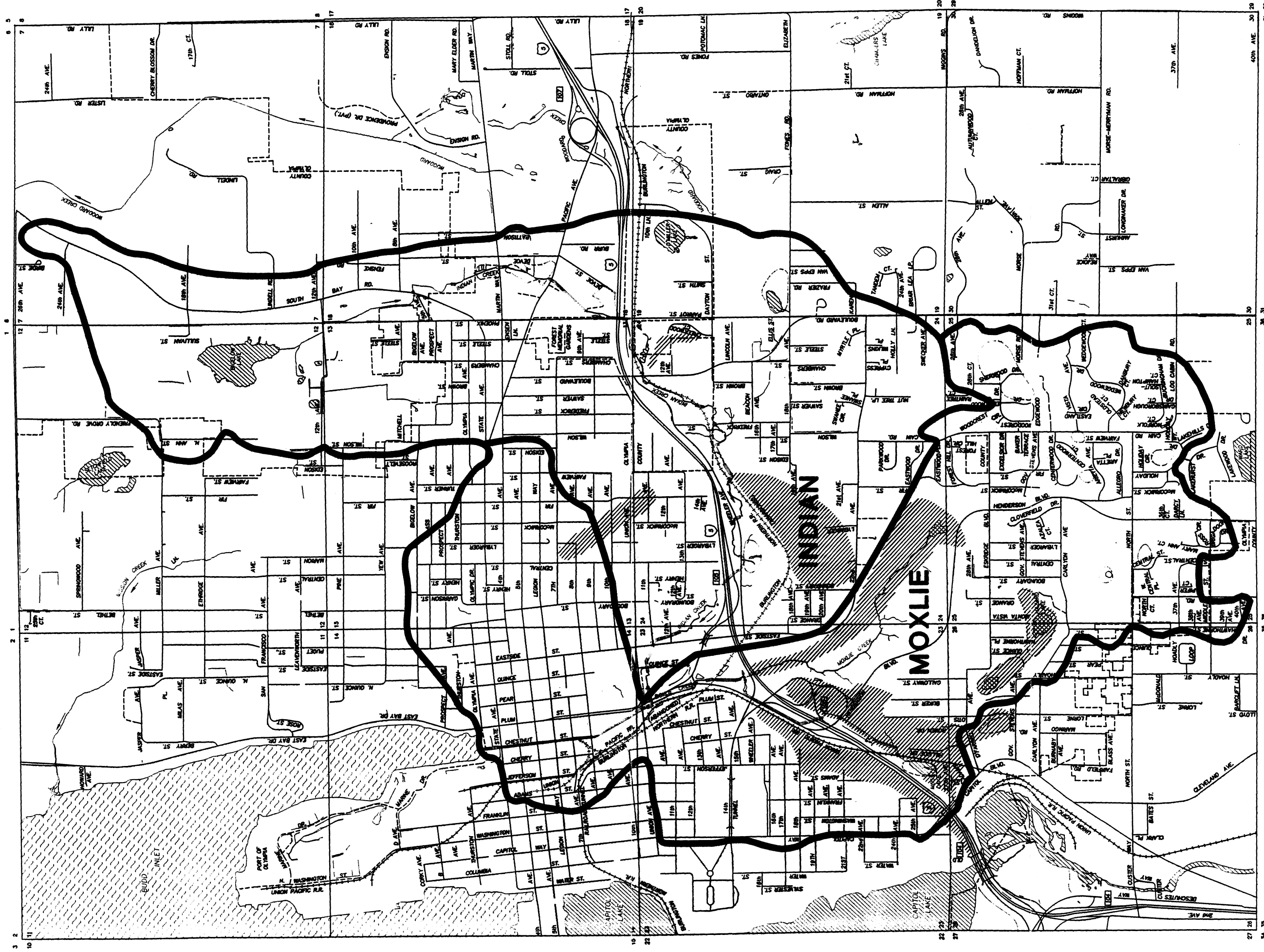

Steep Slope



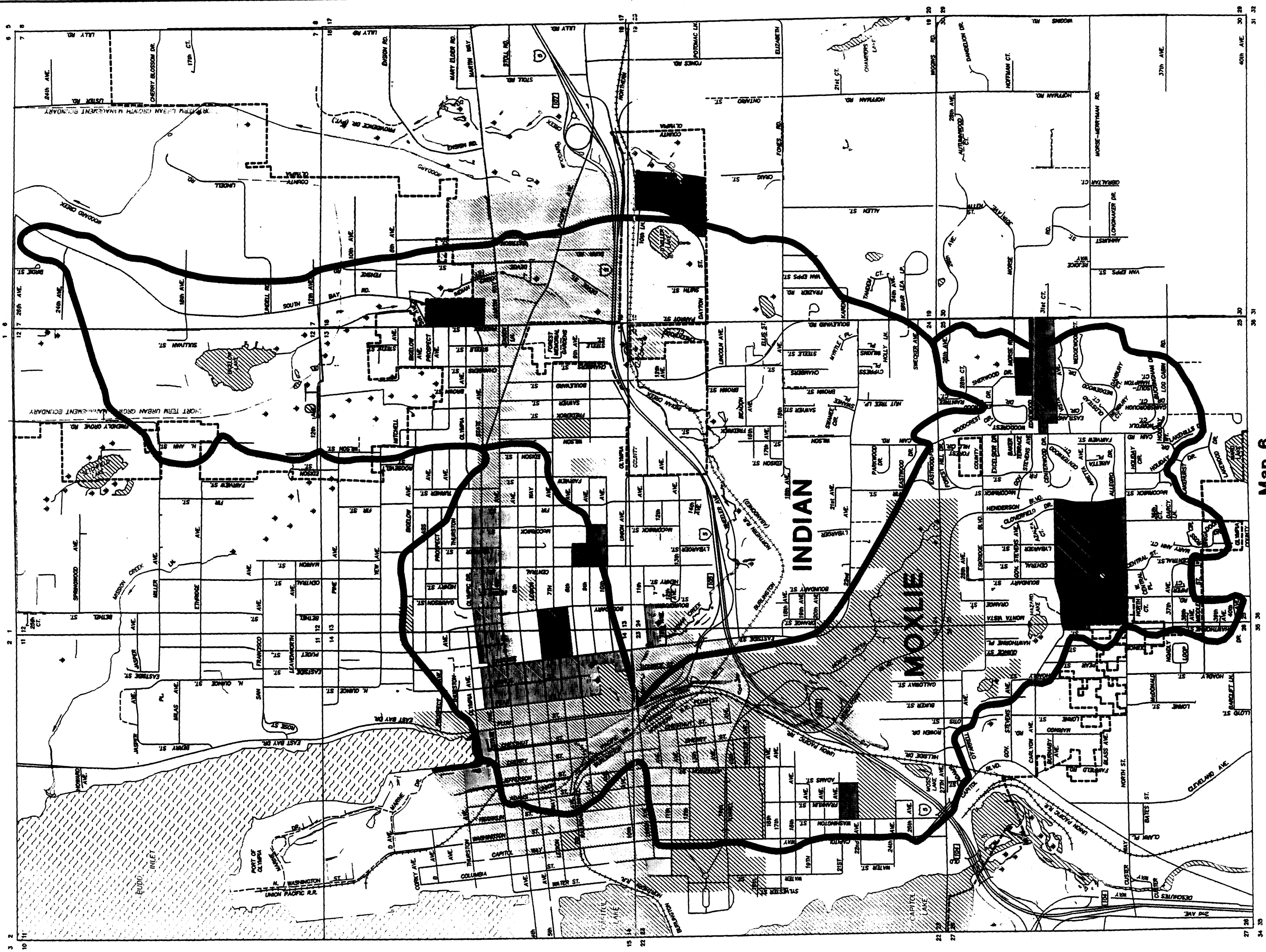

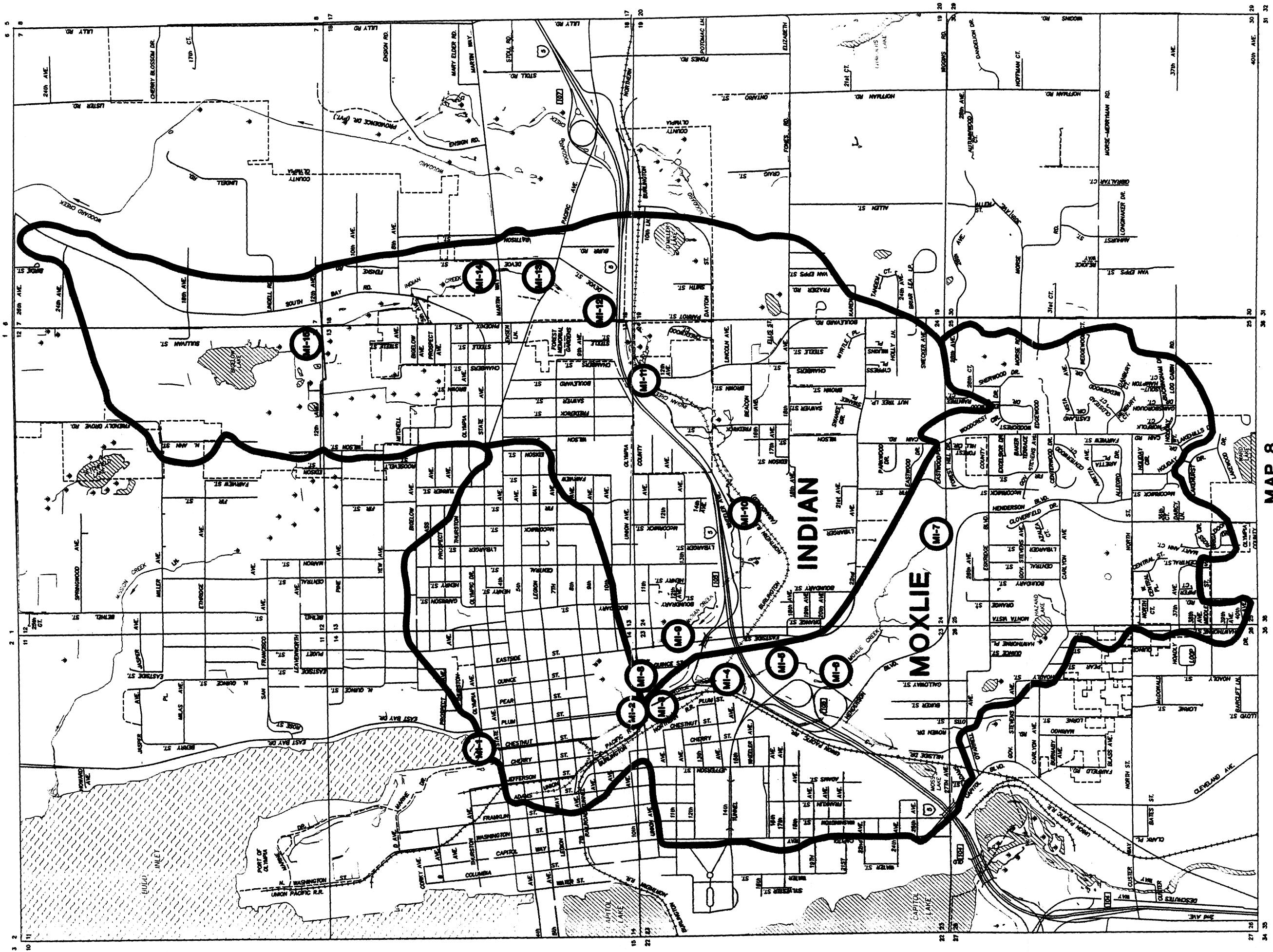

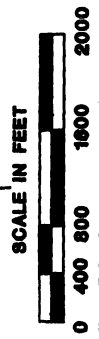


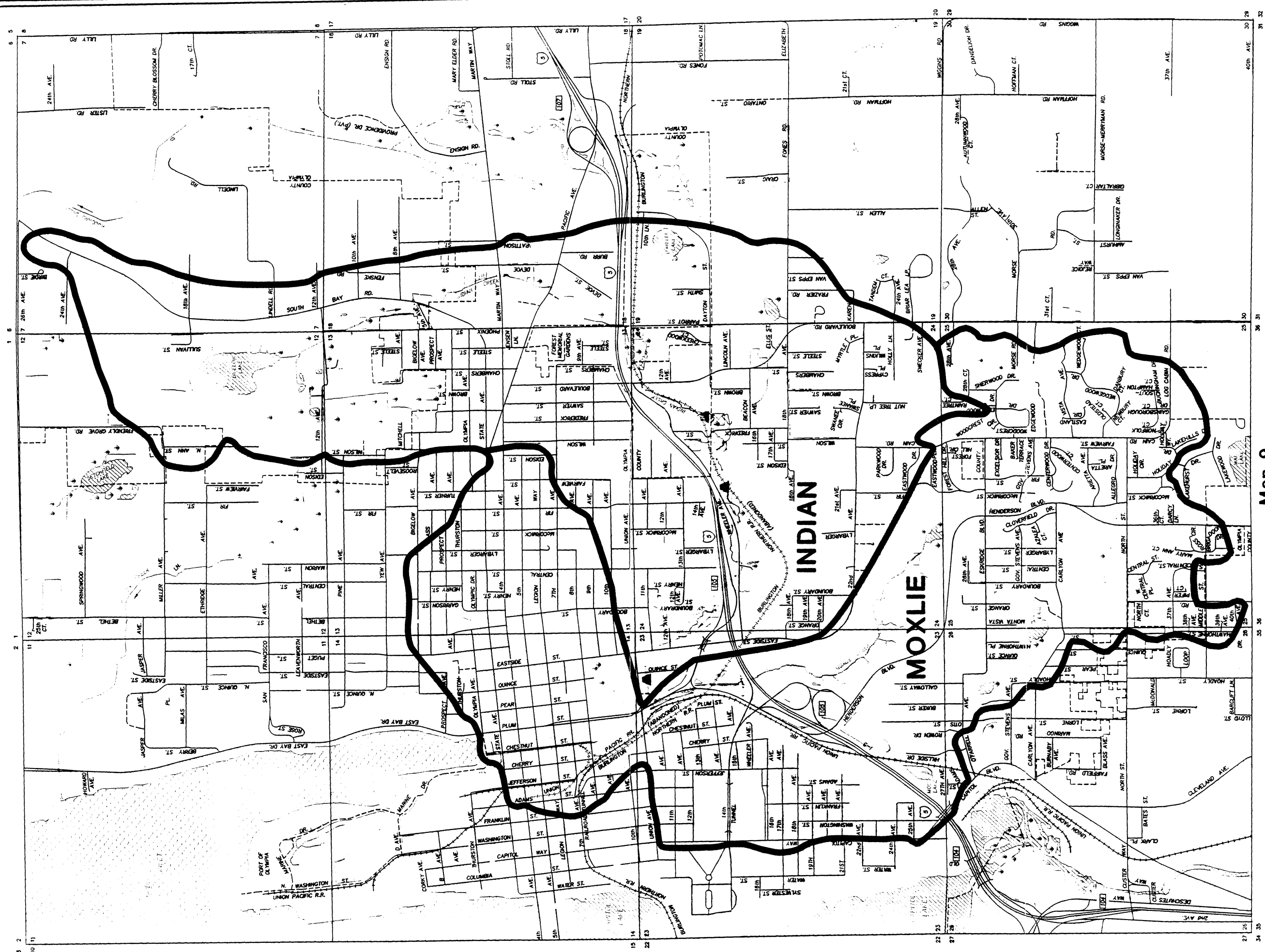
MAP 8
