

# Minimum Qualifications:

#### All Positions (except Explorers):

- Minimum 18 years of age.
- Ability to volunteer 4 hrs. per week.
- Valid WA Driver's License.
- No Criminal History.
- Good Physical Health.

#### Reserve Deputies:

- Minimum 21 years of age.
- U.S. Citizen.
- Must pass background investigation to include; polygraph, psychological, and medical.
- Ability to attend Reserve Academy.
- Commit to 16 hours per month and monthly training meetings.

### Explorers:

- Between 14 and 21 years of age.
- Good Conduct.
- Enrolled in school or earned diploma or GED.
- Minimum 2.0 GPA.
- Written permission of parent/legal guardian.
- Willingness to pay monthly dues.
- Attend Explorer Academy within one year.
