The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Board of County Commissioners approved Capitol Land Trust's request for \$400,000 from the Conservation Futures fund to support the Lower Henderson Inlet Habitat Acquisition (Stillman/Harmony) project. This project involves the acquisition of parcels 11928230200, 11928320500, 11929440200, 11928320000, 11929110500, 11929140000, 11928220800, and 11928230100, totaling approximately one-hundred six (106) acres.


The Board agreed to provide funds for the Lower Henderson Inlet project with the condition that the acquisition be completed no later than December 31, 2018. Please note that you will need to complete a conservation agreement with Thurston County prior to the release of Conservation Futures funds. Also, note that invoices for Conservation Futures funds must be submitted at least two weeks prior to the escrow closing date.
