This presentation will address the address the community and family risk factors that lead to child maltreatment. The presentation will specifically address behavioral health challenges, emotional dysregulation, domestic violence, suicide, children and adolescent behavior challenges and understanding the significance of power struggle behavior in youth who have experienced trauma, are in out-of-home care and maltreatment. Much of the presentation will address strategies to build resiliency for youth and families including enhancing protective factors and utilizing “positive childhood experiences” and the research of managing power struggle behaviors.
