To schedule an emergent motion, you will need to first file a notice of hearing, the motion, supporting materials and proposed order.

Because the clerk's office is closed to in-person filings, you will need to file these documents by mail, by e-filing, or by email (email only possible with the assistance of a clerk's office facilitator [360-786-5430]).

Once the documents have been filed (notice, motion, supporting documents, and proposed order), you may schedule your telephonic participation in the hearing by calling 360-709-3295.
