“Battered Women’s Justice Project”

A presentation by Tracy Shoberg, Deputy Director of SAFeR.

Child custody decision-making in the context of intimate partner violence (“IPV”) allegations can be controversial, unpredictable, and challenging. The family court system struggles to protect the safety and wellbeing of children and their battered parents in IPV-related child custody cases. There is also concern about protecting the rights and interests of parents who are accused of IPV and/or unjustifiably estranged from their children. This presentation describes a four-pronged approach to decision-making in IPV-related parenting cases known as “SAFeR.” The SAFeR approach is designed to produce safer, more workable outcomes for battered parents and their children.
