

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

BOARD OF THURSTON COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

PURPOSE: Public hearing to accept and consider public comments on a proposed ordinance amending Thurston County Code, section 2.130.030, providing for charges for body worn camera recordings and other charges for records set by law. After the public hearing, the Board of County Commissioners may adopt the new ordinance.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE: The Board of County Commissioners will consider adopting an ordinance which would amend Thurston County Code 2.130.030, Public records index and costs for providing copies of public records, to set forth that the charges for body worn camera records shall be the actual costs authorized in the Public Records Act, chapter 42.56 RCW. The proposed ordinance further sets forth that where state or federal law other than the Public Records Act sets a different fee for providing records, the provisions of that other law shall govern.
