

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the adoption of a revised Thurston County Speed Limit Schedule pursuant to RCW 46.61.415 and chapter 12.105 Thurston County Code.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 46.61.415, the Thurston County Public Works Department conducted an engineering and traffic investigation and recommends altering the speed limits on certain Thurston County roads as follows:

- 93rd Avenue SE, from Tilley Road SE to Old Hwy 99 SE – posted 50 mph to 40 mph
- 199th Avenue SE, from the Dead End to Tyrell Road SE – unposted 50 mph to 30 mph
- Case Road SW, from Beaver Creek to Maytown Road SW - posted 50 mph to 40 mph
- Fish Trap Loop NE, from Libby Road NE to Libby Road NE - posted 35 mph to 25 mph
- Houston Drive NW, from the Dead End to 17th Avenue NW – unposted 50 mph to 25 mph
- Rehklau Road SE, from Yelm Hwy SE to the Dead End – posted 35 mph to 25 mph
- Tyrell Road SE, from the Dead End to Skookumchuck Road SE – unposted 50 mph to 30 mph
- Woodard Bay Road NE, from Boston Harbor Road NE to Libby Road NE – unposted 50 mph to 40 mph

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 4, 2022; and

WHEREAS, based on the engineering and traffic investigation conducted by the Department of Public Works and the public comments received, the Board of County Commissioners determines to alter the speed limits on the above-referenced roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THURSTON COUNTY, STATE OF WASHINGTON, that the Thurston County Speed Limit Schedule is hereby amended to read as provided in Attachment "A".


