

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION relating to the adoption of Thurston County Water and Sewer Utility Rates and Charges.

WHEREAS, Thurston County is responsible for managing three water systems and four sewer systems;
and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authority per Chapter 15.12.100 of Thurston
County Code to adjust rates and charges for water and sewer utilities owned and operated by Thurston County;
and

WHEREAS, outreach to customers and future customers occurred to solicit comments and feedback
regarding proposed rate increases for the water and sewer utilities owned and managed by Thurston County; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed Thurston County water and sewer rate adjustments was
held on December 6, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, after considering the testimony presented at the public
hearing, finds that the adoption of a water and sewer rate and charges schedule for 2023 is necessary and required,
and should be adopted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Thurston County, State of Washington,
does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The 2023 water and sewer rates and charges schedule for Thurston County owned and
managed water and sewer utilities, as attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby
adopted.
