Preliminary estimated revenue to support the 2017-2018 biennium budget including proposed mid-term adjustments are:

2017

General Fund Revenues \$ 93,083,979
Other Fund Revenues \$ 201,581,992

2018

General Fund Revenues \$ 95,258,139
Other Fund Revenues \$ 178,067,536

These amounts include a proposal of a one percent increase to the property tax levies for the current expense, road, conservation futures and medic one funds. These amounts also include a proposed levy shift from the road fund to the current expense fund.
