PURPOSE: Public hearing to receive testimony regarding altering the speed limit on various Thurston County Roads. After the public hearing, the Board of County Commissioners may adopt an ordinance amending the Thurston County Speed Limit Schedule.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE: The Board of County Commissioners will consider amending the Thurston County Speed Limit Schedule to alter the speed limit on the following Thurston County Roads:

1. Boston Harbor Road NE, from Boston Harbor Extension Road NE to 73rd Avenue NE – posted 30 mph to 25 mph.
2. Boston Harbor Extension Road NE, from Dead End to Boston Harbor Road NE – unposted 50 mph to 25 mph.
3. 52nd Avenue SW, from Dead End to Black Lake Belmore Road SW - unposted 50 mph to 25 mph.
4. 184th Avenue SE, from Yates Road SE to SR 507 - unposted 50 mph to 25 mph.
