

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Thurston County Commissioners have established the Lawrence Lake Management District No. 18 and will hold a Public Hearing to review written objections to the proposed roll of rates and charges. The proposed roll of rates and charges is available for public perusal at the Thurston County Water and Waste Management Department, 929 Lakeridge Dr. S.W., Bldg. 4, Room 100, Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, until the hearing. The total proposed amounts to be raised during the four-year duration of this district is \$96,000 for the first year, with a maximum escalation for inflation of 5% per year for the following three years. Any objections to the proposed roll must be in writing, including clear grounds for objections and must be submitted to the Thurston County Commissioners, 2000 Lakeridge Drive S.W., Bldg. 1, Olympia, WA 98502. Although the Commissioners can accept objections anytime prior to the public hearing, as a courtesy and to allow for staff reports and scheduling for each objection, please file objections by 5:00 p.m. on August 6, 2007 at 2000 Lakeridge Drive S.W., Bldg. 1, Olympia, WA 98502. Failure to submit a written objection shall be deemed as a waiver of objection.
