Thurston County Superior Court seeks to contract with therapists who are qualified in EMDR therapy and who meet the following criteria:

- 1) EMDRIA Approved Training:** Submit evidence of having completed an EMDRIA approved Basic EMDR Training program. A copy of your certificate of completion is required.
- 2) License/Certification:** Show evidence of a license/certification/registration with the Washington Department of Health as a mental health professional. A photocopy of your license/certification/registration to practice independently in the mental health field is also required.
- 3) At least three years of experience after completing an EMDRIA approved training program.** Applicants **MUST** have the minimum 3 years of experience after completion of the Basic EMDR Training.
