## **CERTIFICATE OF WATER AVAILABILITY (COWA)**

### Connection to (1) or two (2) Single Family Residential Connections to one Water Source

Purpose: An approved COWA is required prior to issuance of all building or septic permits when potable drinking water is required. This is to assure the availability of potable drinking water per RCW 19.27 and Article III of the

Thurston County Sanitary Code.

# CERTIFICATE OF WATER AVAILABILITY (COWA) INSTRUCTIONS CONNECTION TO ONE (1) OR TWO (2) SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL WATER SUPPLY

**STEP 1** Complete the applicant section on the application form.

#### **STEP 2** Attach copy of:

- Well driller construction report (well log)
- Well source capacity pump test (attach pump test if capacity is not listed on well log or if the capacity data indicates a flow of less than three(3) gallons per minute)
- Water Quality Test Reports: Coliform, Nitrate, and other test reports when applicable

#### If the water system is located off-site, attach the following additional items:

- Waterline & source access easements, when applicable
- Water Rights, when applicable
- Surface Water Treatment Design and Notice Regarding Use of Surface Water, when applicable
- **STEP 3** Submit the COWA form with attached documents to:

**STEP 4** Building Development Center staff will review the documents and issue the certificate if the requirements to demonstrate water availability are met.
