Proposed Changes

- Definitions: Some match the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) and some had more room for discretion. Some were deleted if the term is no longer used.
 - Terms like "Base Station", "Collocation", "Eligible Facilities Request", and "Substantial Change" are more consistent with the FCC.
 - Terms like "Alternative Support Structure," "Concealed Support Structure," and "Rights-of-way" were more tailored.

Special Uses – Use Table

- Zones left out in previous drat
- Clarified that Collocations would be Administrative Special Use permits
- "Shot Clocks"
- Cannot create new permit review process

Proposed Changes

- Small Wireless Facilities (SWF)
 - New term
 - Largely used in the rights-of-way
- Clarify process requirements
 - Some language changes around application submittals
 - Includes specific information on shot clocks and appeal
 - Design Standards updated
- Removed outdated requirements
 - "Gap in coverage"
 - Radio Frequency testing limits
 - Redundancies
