Welcome & Introductions

Patrick O'Connor welcomed everyone and opened the meeting at 4:00 pm. Everyone introduced themselves. The council meeting was held in person and over Zoom.

APPR Project Update

Marianne Clear gave an update on APPR and the Pretrial Services grant. For past 3 ½ years several stakeholders have worked on establishing committees & work groups, mapped superior court from beginning to end, and worked on a dashboard. A violent offense list was put together, and a conditions of release matrix created.

Strategic Planning Subcommittee Update

Leah Landon explained the strategic planning process. In 2015 this committee served as the action team for public safety committee for Thurston Thrives. At the October 2022 meeting it was decided the strategic map that was created in 2015 needs to be updated. A subgroup was formed, and has met a few times, and will be meeting February 10 to put together a plan with definitions of the values.

Data Subcommittee Update

Leah explained this subcommittee's goal is to have one countywide law and justice data warehouse. It will track/measure a person from when they are arrested, through when they are in jail, and goes through the court system to when they are released. Members of this subcommittee is anyone who can contribute to this data. (courts, clerks, pretrial services, TST, defense council and the sheriff's office). If you have data points you want to see please let Leah know.
